NIH Main Campus Building 10 (Clinical Center) Masur Auditorium 10 Center Dr, Bethesda, MD 20814

Getting There (Parking and Shuttle Info):

- Parking on the NIH Campus is extremely limited and can be expensive. Because of this, we
 highly recommend taking Metro to the Medical Center stop on the red line if possible. If you
 are at a nearby hotel, please check with your hotel's front desk to see if they offer shuttle
 service to NIH. You may also consider walking.
- If you do wish to drive and park, please use the lots at the Visitor's Center. Please consult the NIH Parking Map for more information.

Arrival Time:

All participants without NIH badges will need to go through Visitor's Security at the NIH
Gateway Center. This is just above the metro exit. Please arrive about 30 minutes prior to the
meeting start time to go through security and walk or take the shuttle to Building 10. Be sure to
bring a license or passport for check-in, and consult the NIH Visitor Information Website for

additional information. It is about a 7-10 minute walk from the entrance to Masur Auditorium. The event will run from << 9am to 5pm with 1 hour for lunch at 12:30 pm each day.>>

Coffee/ Lunch:

 There is a cafeteria on the lower level of Building 10, an Au Bon Pain in the adjacent building, and a smaller cafeteria on the second floor of the clinical center. All food is available for purchase.
