NLM EHR Project Highlights

The goal of this 2 year contract is to provide Government Agencies and the private sector with an implementation guide for the transmission of patient information between disparate electronic health record (EHR) systems.

NLM Vocabulary Project Highlights

The goal of this 3 year contract is to 1) make HL7 vocabularies available from within the Universal Medical Language System (UMLS) 2) where possible replace HL7 vocabularies with designated Consolidated Health Initiative (CHI) vocabularies 3) describe how vocabulary bindings to from specific HL7 messages to the UMLS will occur. Vocabulary access, maintenance and collaboration tooling will also be developed as required for the project. All activity will be coordinated using established HL7 processes and documented in implementation guide
