

Patient advocates often do not provide the technology. But their commitment to our fundamental processes are invaluable.


Their reach is global. Their goals know no national borders.

#### CHALLENGES

- Multiple EHR Systems
- Patient consent given multiple times (on paper)
- Wrong insurance charged
- Patient emails invoices
- Sometimes Patient pays and is reimbursed



#### **Prior Authorization**

- Critical Procedures Delayed or Cancelled
- Example: Physical Therapy
  - Payer asks for detailed information
  - Providers frustrated with the barrage of questions
    - Decision: Life Care Planner to assess long-term care and vocational needs in 60 days. Permission for outpatient rehab given after 5 months






